The Lead-Based Paint Renovation Rule, effective April 22, 2010 is an EPA rule affecting construction contractors, residential landlords, property managers and others who perform “renovations” for compensation in housing that may contain lead-based paint—that is built before 1978. The term “renovation” includes most repair, remodeling and maintenance activities that disturb painted surface. This disclosure is required only for buildings built prior to 1978.
